## **TRANSPERSONAL INTEGRATIVE NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE COUNCIL (TINMC)**

*Faith-Based and Philosophical Council under the Transcendentalism-PH Institute*

### **I. OFFICIAL CHARTER AND ORGANIZATIONAL PROFILE**

#### **Founding Vision**

The Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council (TINMC) was founded to uphold, preserve, and evolve the sacred discipline of Transpersonal and Integrative Naturopathic Medicine.

Rooted in the consciousness philosophy of Transcendentalism-PH, it stands as a faith-based professional body devoted to the recognition of healing as both an art of nature and a ministry of spirit.

#### **Mandate and Purpose**

The Council exists to:

- Promote professional fellowship, continuing education, and ethical practice among faith-based naturopathic practitioners.
- Recognize and accredit members aligned with Transpersonal-Integrative standards of natural and consciousness-based healing.
- Foster unity among practitioners of holistic and spiritual medicine within the greater context of ecology, faith, and Oversoul awareness.
- Proclaim that “Nature Heals through the Oversoul”, affirming that healing begins from harmony with the divine intelligence of life.

## Spiritual and Legal Foundation

The TINMC functions under the protection of the Philippine Constitution, Article III, Bill of Rights, Section 5, which declares:

*“No law shall be made respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof.”*

Thus, all credentials, recognitions, and certifications issued by the Council are faith-based, philosophical, and spiritual in nature, and do not substitute for government-issued licenses.

## Official Emblem



The official emblem of the Council is a shield of emerald green and gold, symbolizing wisdom, healing, and divine protection.

At its heart stands the Caduceus, flanked by two sacred symbols:

- *A mortar and pestle with a sprouting leaf* — representing herbal and botanical medicine.
- *A therapeutic figure* — representing manual and energy healing.
- *Above the Caduceus shines a chakra wheel*, representing the light of consciousness and divine unity.

Motto: *“Vis Medicatrix Naturae” — The Healing Power of Nature.*

## Organizational Structure

- Supreme Council of Naturopathic Integrators – Governing body overseeing policy, vision, and ethics. [ This is the Council Administration composed of the Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer].
- Board of Academic Fellows – Guardians of education, research, and standards.
- Council Secretariat – Administrative center for records and member documentation.
- Regional and International Chapters – Promote advocacy, education, and spiritual fellowship.

*The Council is a purely telematic organization [ blended correspondence and online]. Being “telematic-based “ organization, the monthly overhead cost is very minimal and that is why the Council does not require members for a monthly and yearly dues.*

## Ethical Creed

Members of the Council solemnly affirm the Transpersonal Oath of Healing, pledging to honor the sanctity of life, respect for nature, and the divine consciousness that animates all beings.

## 2. Constitution and By-Laws of the Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council (TINMC)

*Under the Philosophical Faith of Transcendentalism-PH*

### PREAMBLE

We, the Transpersonal Integrative Naturopaths of the Philippines, united by the light of the **Oversoul** and guided by the principles of **Transcendentalism-PH**, hereby establish this **Constitution and By-Laws** of the **Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council (TINMC)** — a faith-based and philosophical body devoted to the evolution of natural healing consciousness.

Recognizing the divine harmony between Nature and Spirit, and invoking the protection of **Article III, Section 5 of the Philippine Constitution** —

*“No law shall be made respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof” —*

we affirm our sacred right to practice, teach, and propagate Transpersonal-Naturopathic Medicine as a spiritual-philosophical vocation of service and healing.

### ARTICLE I — NAME, NATURE, AND CHARACTER

1. The organization shall be known as the **Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council (TINMC)**.
2. It is a **faith-based, non-sectarian, philosophical council** devoted to the advancement of holistic healing founded upon the tenets of **Transcendentalism-PH**.
3. The Council is **not a government agency**, nor does it issue state-recognized licenses; rather, it is a **spiritual-professional fraternity**

that affirms the healer’s divine vocation and ethical duty to serve humanity.

4. It operates as an **autonomous faith community** within the protection of the Bill of Rights and under the auspices of the **Transcendentalism-PH Institute**.

## **ARTICLE II — VISION AND MISSION**

### **Vision**

To be the leading faith-based body uniting natural healers, transpersonal practitioners, and consciousness-based physicians in the pursuit of **spiritual, ecological, and integrative healing**.

### **Mission**

To uphold the spiritual art and science of naturopathic healing; to accredit, guide, and protect faith-based healers; and to cultivate a community of compassion, ethics, and enlightenment.

## **ARTICLE III — OBJECTIVES AND FUNCTIONS**

1. To accredit and recognize **faith-based naturopathic practitioners** aligned with Transcendentalism-PH philosophy.
2. To develop **ethical and spiritual standards** for transpersonal healing practice.
3. To provide **education, certification, and continuing development** through correspondence and blended learning programs.
4. To advocate **freedom of healing and conscience** within constitutional bounds.
5. To preserve the integrity of the naturopathic calling as a **service**

**of the soul, mind, and body.**

6. To serve as a **professional fellowship** for mutual learning, research, and support.

7. To cooperate with local and international councils that share similar ideals.

## **ARTICLE IV — MEMBERSHIP**

### **Section 1. Categories**

- **Regular Members** – graduates of the Diploma in Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathy (CTIN).
- **Fellow Members** – recognized for outstanding contributions, research, or teaching in the field.
- **Honorary Members** – conferred upon distinguished individuals supporting the Council’s vision.
- **Institutional Members** – partner schools, organizations, or healing centers.

### **Section 2. Rights and Privileges**

Members shall have the right to:

1. Vote, be voted upon, and participate in all activities of the Council.
2. Receive certificates, credentials, and continuing formation.
3. Use the professional designation **CTIN** within the scope of faith-based practice.
4. Enjoy protection under the Council’s moral and spiritual recognition.

### **Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities**

Members shall:

1. Uphold the Transpersonal-Naturopathic Code of Ethics.
2. Maintain integrity, compassion, and non-commercial conduct in healing.
3. Support the Council through contributions and voluntary service.
4. Refrain from acts contrary to the dignity of the profession.

## **ARTICLE V — GOVERNANCE AND ADMINISTRATION**

### **Section 1. Supreme Council**

The governing body shall be the **Supreme Council of TINMC**, composed of:

- **Chairperson**
- **Vice-Chairperson**
- **Secretary-General**
- **Registrar**
- **Treasurer**
- **Director for Education and Accreditation**
- **Director for Membership and Promotion**
- **Spiritual Adviser / Consultant**

### **Section 2. Powers and Duties**

1. Formulate policies, programs, and standards.
2. Approve membership and fellowship applications.



3. Oversee educational and ethical compliance.
4. Represent the Council in national and international affairs.
5. Convene assemblies and enact resolutions.

### **Section 3. Tenure**

Members of the Supreme Council shall serve for **three (3) years**, renewable by consensus or election during the General Assembly.

### **ARTICLE VI — MEETINGS AND ASSEMBLIES**

1. The **General Assembly** shall convene at least once a year for policy ratification, induction, and fellowship.
2. **Special Meetings** may be called by the Chairperson or by one-third of the Council members.
3. A **quorum** shall consist of at least half of active members.
4. Decisions shall be made by **majority vote** unless otherwise provided.

### **ARTICLE VII — CODE OF ETHICS AND SPIRITUAL CONDUCT**

1. The practice of Transpersonal-Naturopathic Medicine is both a **science and a sacred calling**.
2. Practitioners must maintain compassion, humility, confidentiality, and non-discrimination.
3. No member shall exploit patients for material or political gain.
4. Healing acts must honor **Nature, the Oversoul, and the free will of the individual**.
5. Members shall live by the guiding prayer: *“May every hand that heals be guided by love, and every heart that learns be lifted toward truth.”*

## **ARTICLE VIII — FUNDS AND PROPERTY**

1. The Council shall maintain funds from membership fees, donations, and voluntary contributions.
2. All financial transactions shall be transparent and used solely for the Council's mission.
3. No officer shall personally benefit from Council funds beyond legitimate reimbursements.

## **ARTICLE IX — AMENDMENTS**

Amendments to this Constitution and By-Laws may be proposed by any member of the Supreme Council or by one-third of the General Assembly, and shall take effect upon ratification by a two-thirds majority vote.

## **ARTICLE X — RATIFICATION**

This Constitution and By-Laws shall take effect upon its adoption by the founding members of the Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council, duly convened under the spiritual auspices of **Transcendentalism-PH** on this day of November 4 in the year of the Oversoul, 2025.

### 3. Frequently Ask Question [FAQ]

#### 1. What is the Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council (TINMC)?

The Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council is a faith-based and philosophical organization dedicated to the ethical, spiritual, and educational advancement of Transpersonal and Integrative Naturopathic Medicine.

It operates under the Transcendentalism-PH Institute, serving as a Council of practitioners devoted to the consciousness-centered, nature-aligned, and Oversoul-inspired path of healing.

#### 2. Is TINMC a government regulatory body?

No. TINMC is not a government regulatory agency. It is a faith-based professional body functioning under the constitutional right to religious freedom as guaranteed by the Philippine Constitution, Article III, Section 5, which declares:

*“No law shall be made respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof.”*

Its certificates and recognitions are faith-based and philosophical credentials, not government-issued professional licenses.

**3. Is the Certificate of Membership issued by TINMC valid or recognized by the government?**

Yes — it is valid within the context of faith-based and philosophical recognition, symbolizing the member’s adherence to the Council’s principles of holistic and spiritual healing.

However, it is not a statutory license and is not issued by the government. It serves as a moral and philosophical credential, acknowledged within Transcendentalism-PH and allied organizations in the integrative medicine community.

**4. Is the Diploma issued by the Transcendentalism-PH Institute legal and honored in the Philippines?**

Yes. The Transcendentalism-PH Institute is a faith-based educational institution, functioning legally under the freedom of belief and association granted by the Constitution.

Its diplomas are legal as faith-based and ecclesiastical recognitions, symbolizing completion of spiritual-philosophical studies. However, they do not replace degrees issued by CHED-accredited schools or licenses issued by the DOH, PITAHC, or PRC.

Their honor and validity rest within the faith-based, private, and international philosophical community to which Transcendentalism-PH belongs.

**5. Are the signatories authorized to issue these certificates and diplomas?**

Yes. The signatories — including Dr. Raul O. Cardona, NMD, DSc, NTS, and other authorized officers — act under the charter authority of the Transcendentalism-PH Institute and the TINMC.

They are legally and morally empowered to issue credentials within the faith-based and philosophical domain of Transcendentalism-PH, consistent with its founding constitution, internal bylaws, and the provisions of freedom of belief.

**6. Are the courses offered by Transcendentalism-PH Institute registered or recognized by the DOH or PITAHC?**

No. The programs are not registered with the Department of Health (DOH) or PITAHC, as they are faith-based educational offerings, not government-regulated vocational programs.

They are designed to develop spiritual and philosophical healers who integrate natural medicine with consciousness studies.

Graduates are encouraged to seek additional training or certifications from DOH/PITAHC-accredited schools should they wish to engage in government-regulated modalities.

## 7. Is TINMC or Transcendentalism-PH SEC registered? If so, why?

Transcendentalism-PH, as a *spiritual-philosophical faith*, does not seek registration with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) because it intentionally chooses to remain non-organized, non-sectarian, and non-dogmatic.

It is not a church, corporation, or organized religion, but a living philosophy and inner science of consciousness — a *faith of freedom* whose foundation is direct spiritual experience rather than institutional control.

However, the Transcendentalism-PH Institute, which serves as the *educational and correspondence arm* of this philosophy, is legally registered with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) in the Philippines.

This registration grants the Institute legal personality to operate correspondence courses, issue diplomas, and conduct educational activities under the laws governing private enterprises and faith-based education.

The DTI registration serves administrative and functional purposes, ensuring that:

- The Institute may operate transparently as a faith-based educational provider.
- Students and practitioners may legally enroll in its programs with due public accountability.

The Transcendentalism-PH name is recognized and protected under Philippine trade and intellectual property laws.

Thus, while Transcendentalism-PH remains an *unorganized and free philosophical faith*, the Transcendentalism-PH Institute holds DTI registration to secure lawful recognition as its educational and correspondence institution.

The Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council (TINMC) functions under this lawful educational umbrella, maintaining its spiritual autonomy and philosophical freedom in full harmony with Philippine law.

**[Note: *To avoid controversy, registration to the Securities and Exchange Commission is now on process.*]**

#### **8. What is the philosophical foundation of TINMC?**

TINMC is grounded in Transcendentalism-PH, a philosophy that teaches healing as the remembrance of the Oversoul's perfection. Its foundation rests on the trinity of Body, Nature, and Spirit, expressing the belief that true healing arises from alignment with natural law and divine consciousness.

#### **Guiding maxim:**

*"Vis Medicatrix Naturae" — The Healing Power of Nature.*

#### **9. What does "Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine" mean?**

It is a holistic science of healing uniting:

- Natural and botanical medicine
- Transpersonal psychology and consciousness studies

- Spiritual ecology and planetary wellness
  - Inner technology and Oversoul meditation

#### **10. Who can become a member of TINMC?**

Membership is open to all graduates and practitioners of faith-based and integrative naturopathic programs, educators, and healers who embrace the Council's spiritual-scientific philosophy and ethical creed.

#### **11. What are the ethical principles of the Council?**

Members uphold the Transpersonal Oath of Healing, affirming to:

- Serve life and nature with reverence.
- Practice with compassion, wisdom, and humility.
- Recognize the Oversoul as the true Healer.
- Honor both science and spirit as sacred.

#### **12. What is the role of the Transcendentalism-PH Institute?**

The Institute acts as the spiritual and educational parent body of TINMC. It provides philosophical guidance, academic structure, and inter-organizational alignment to ensure all Council members live by the higher ethics of Transpersonal Healing.

#### **13. What is the symbolism of the Council's emblem?**

The emerald-green and gold shield represents divine protection and enlightenment.

At its center are symbols of the Caduceus (wisdom and energy balance), Mortar and Pestle (natural healing), Therapist Figure (manual

therapy), and Chakra Wheel (consciousness).

Together, they embody the eternal motto: *“Vis Medicatrix Naturae.”*

#### **14. What is the ultimate mission of TINMC?**

The Council exists to restore the sacred consciousness of healing — merging scientific understanding with the wisdom of nature and the divinity of the soul.

Its vision is to nurture Transpersonal Healers who embody the truth that:

*“Healing is the remembrance of divine wholeness.”*

## TINMC Member's Oath (For the Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council)

6. **That I shall not exploit, deceive, or defraud** any seeker, client, or student — and that I shall keep confidentiality, respect personal journeys, and teach only what uplifts the soul.
7. **That I shall work in harmony with fellow healers, educators, and counselors** within the Transpersonal Integrative Naturopathic Medicine Council, fostering unity, not rivalry; service, not self-promotion.
8. **That I shall live what I teach** — practicing simplicity, ecological living, and compassion for all beings, knowing that the healer's character is part of the medicine.
9. **That I shall continually study, meditate, and refine my inner instrument** so that my hands may heal, my words may bless, and my presence may bring peace.

**10. That I receive this faith-based recognition** not as a title of superiority, but as a trust — to guide, to serve, and to protect the sacred tradition of transpersonal, nature-centered, Oversoul-guided healing.
